2024 GRENACHE BLANC

APPELLATION & VINEYARDS

The historic Priest Ranch is now part of the Somerston Estate, a significant property totaling 1,682 acres with 244 acres planted to hillside vineyards. The wines of Priest Ranch are blends from multiple blocks that showcase the diversity and complexity of the combined property. In 2024, the Grenache Blanc grapes were selected from a single vineyard block planted at an elevation of 1,250 feet.

WINEMAKING

Priest Ranch Grenache Blanc was fermented in stainless steel drums and tanks. Native yeasts fermented the wine at a controlled 60 degrees F. The lees were stirred twice a month for seven months before the wine was bottled.

HARVEST NOTES

The 2024 Napa Valley harvest was dynamic and rich in flavor, blending boldness with elegance. Heavy winter rains set the vines up for success, providing natural canopy protection during an unusually hot

summer. It was a textbook yet compact season, requiring teamwork and flexibility.

TASTING NOTES

Our 2024 Grenache Blanc is a vibrant, crisp white wine with beautifully balanced acidity. The nose bursts with bright citrus, pear, and honeysuckle aromas, leading to a palate layered with green apple, white peach, and a hint of minerality. A refreshing, clean finish makes it perfect to enjoy with triple cream cheese, spicy dishes, or simply on its own.
